So much has been accomplished since we began over twenty years ago. Through your support we have given more than four million, (\$4,000,000) dollars to help ... *those struggling with cancer.*

We've contributed to Calvary Hospital, where our Mother was treated and where hundreds have been admitted and treated since the passage of the End of Life Care Law, which gives terminally ill cancer patients the chance to spend their final days being treated with dignity and respect at a terminal care hospital. The Foundation was instrumental in the passage of this law which would not have been possible without your support.

Calvary Hospital has recognized our efforts by naming the third floor south wing where our Mother was a patient, "Pat Cairo Hall". It is a memorial to our Mother and a tribute to all that we, together, have accomplished.

We've also supported our Mother's doctor, Carolyn Runowicz, M.D. , past President of the American Cancer Society . One of her greatest accomplishments was the significant contribution her research team made to the development of a vaccine approved by the FDA in June 2006 which prevents the cancer our Mother suffered from. This vaccine ensures no other woman will lose her life to this form of cancer. Dr. Runowicz has stated that her research would not have been possible without our financial support.

Calvary Hospital presented its *Inaugural Calvary Compator Award* to our father and the Foundation. The Award is in recognition of the significant partnership between our Foundation and Calvary Hospital to provide exceptional end-of-life care for cancer patients and their families.

On November 30, 2016, Calvary Hospital hosted a Ribbon Cutting and Dedication of the four recently renovated and furnished nurses' lounges. This gift to the nurses in appreciation of all they do was made by *The Pat Cairo Family Foundation.*

All that we have accomplished would be impossible without your support. Thanks for all you do.
